Return and recycling under the Act Governing the Sale, Return, and **Environmentally Sound Disposal of Electrical and Electronic Equipment** (Elektro- und Elektronikgerätegesetz – ElektroG)

Statement

Customers can return their waste electrical and electronic devices.

In the case of waste electrical and electronic devices ("devices") that may have come into contact with hazardous substances, the user must enclose a declaration of no objection with the returned device. This declaration of no objection is completed as a return form (decontamination declaration) on the website.

- Any used (rechargeable) batteries must be removed prior to return. They can be sent to us for proper disposal as well.
- Personal data on the devices must be erased before they are returned.
- The sender is responsible for the shipping costs to return the waste products to Knick.

Knick works only with certified disposal companies and submits the devices to them for professional disposal and/or recycling.

symbol on Knick products means that the waste devices must be disposed of separately from unsorted municipal waste.
